Golf and Non-Golf Dress code

To ensure that the dress code at The Country Club Johannesburg is upheld at all times, the Golf Committee and Club Management will be closely monitoring the attire worn by both golfers and non-golfers. These dress regulations apply to all club facilities. We ask that members please make themselves aware of the club dress regulations as well as ensuring guests are made aware of these guidelines.

Golfers wearing the inappropriate dress code will be asked to change their clothing before making their way onto either the practice facilities or golf course.

Management and employees have both the responsibility and authority to interpret appropriate wear and to ensure that standards are maintained.

Trousers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Traditional long golf trousers with belt or clasp.Formal three-quarter length golf trousers may not be worn (no jeans).	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Traditional long or unfaded and untornd jeans.Long trousers are required in the ba, function rooms Grill Room, Club Room and Gallery after 18:00.
Shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Traditional shorts with belt or clasp are permitted.No shorts extending over the knee or with patch/cargo pockets are permitted	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Shorts may be worn in the clubhouse.No shorts extending over the knee or with patch/cargo pockets are permitted.Shorts are not permitted in the Bar or Grill restaurant.Players wearing shorts after 18:00 may sit on the outside patio's.
Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Traditional knee-length golf socks may be worn with short trousers.Short socks and anklets must be predominantly white, unless colour coordinated with a golf outfit.	
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Only closed heel golf shoes with soft spikes are permitted.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Closed shoes must be worn in the Members Bar.

Headwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Traditional golf hats or peak caps. Caps to be worn with peak forward. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hats and caps may be worn in the Sandwedge during the round. All peaks and hats to be taken off and not to be worn in the clubhouse after completion of golf.
Shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Traditional collared or crew neck golf shirts. Tailored waist length ladies golf shirts need not be tucked in. Sleeveless golf shirts may also be worn. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Regular collared golf shirts or crew neck golf shirts, tucked into trousers or skirts. Blouses may be worn over trousers and skirts. T-shirts and sports attire may be worn. No t-shirts in the Members Bar.
Trousers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Traditional long or short golf trousers with belt or clasp. Formal three-quarter length golf trousers may be worn. 	
Shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Traditional shorts with belt or clasp are permitted. No cargo or denim shorts will be permitted. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shorts may be worn in the clubhouse. No shorts extending over the knee or with patch/cargo pockets are permitted in the Bar and Grill. Shorts are not permitted in the Bar Players wearing shorts after 18:00 may sit on the outside patio's.
Skirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Appropriate length golf skirts. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Skirts with or without tailored jackets.
Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Short socks and anklets must be predominantly white, unless colour coordinated with a golf outfit. 	
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Only closed heel golf shoes with soft spikes are permitted. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Formal or casual shoes and sandals.

The following items will not be permitted on the course and in selected venues under any circumstances:

- Tee shirts
- Bold commercial advertising
- Tracksuits
- Draw-string or elasticised pants
- Bush-type or cargo pants
- Jeans
